

Corrosion Coupon Guidelines

The coupons can be sent by the carrier of your choice. (However, we have had issues with US Postal Service bending coupons, but any carrier can do that.)

Coupons should be properly labeled as follows:

- Alloy
- Starting weight
- System/location
- Date in
- Date out

The coupon must be returned in its own VCI (vapor corrosion inhibited) envelope. Otherwise, corrosion will continue on the coupon after it is removed from the system.

Corrosion Coupons are analyzed once a month. Coupons must be received by the last day of the month to be processed on the first Wednesday of the following month.

If you need coupons analyzed before then, a rush charge of \$50 per coupon will apply.

Standard services:

Coupons will be photographed before and after cleaning. Metal loss will be recorded. We will provide a report on the cleaning and it will be emailed to the requested party.

Coupons will be recycled after examination.

If you desire to have the coupon back, you will be responsible for a \$10 fee per coupon and shipping charges. Please provide the shipping information for return. We cannot guarantee the coupon will not be damaged during the shipping process.

Coupon depth analysis is an additional \$38 per coupon.
